WHAT IS COMFORT ZONE?

Comfort Zone Camp is a national nonprofit organization that provides a safe and fun place for kids grieving the death of a parent, sibling, or significant person in their life. CZC offers FREE one day family programs and 3-day weekend camps. All programming empowers children to grieve, heal and grow in healthy ways.

WHAT IS A WEEKEND CAMP?

This three day program is a strength-based, child-focused model, which includes age-based support groups facilitate by trained grief specialists. The program will facilitate icebreakers, confidence-building activities and other activities designed to facilitate trust, expression, and interaction among them.

CAMP MODELS & ELIGIBILITY

TRADITIONAL CAMP: Youth must be between the ages of 7-17 (18 if still in high school), and experienced the death of a parent, sibling, or significant person. Contact CZC staff, Kim Elder, at kelder@comfortzonecamp.org with any questions.
